## The Five Steps Events to Salvation!

To call the path to salvation a system of "steps" is to turn the journey to eternal life into a list of 'to-do' items to check off as each is accomplished.

Salvation and the heart of man runs much deeper than that. Yes, there are certain uncompromisable events that I must engage in with my body *and my mind*.

And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God. ~ Romans 12:-2

The 5 or 6 step plan the Church of Christ is well known for is of course *the necessity* to Hear the Gospel of Christ, to Believe the Gospel of Christ, Repent and turn to Christ, Confess Jesus Christ, and be Baptized in the Name of the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. The sixth is to Continue your walk in the faith.

They are essential to salvation and actually are closer to "events" experienced than an item on a list to check off. But we know the Christian journey through this temporary world is much richer and deeper than a system of steps.

Saul, soon to be Apostle Paul, certainly did not follow a check list of steps in his conversion. Though it was quite an *event* on the road to Damascus when he first HEARD and soon after BELIEVED that Jesus was the Christ, the Son of God!

Years later in his letter to the Romans he asks, how can salvation even take place without FIRST hearing and believing?

"For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved. How then shall they call on him in whom they have not believed? and how shall they BELIEVE in him of whom they have not heard? and how shall they HEAR without a preacher? ~ Romans 10:13-14

Despite this, I recently had a number of discussions with friends and acquaintances from other faiths of all kinds who discredit this, calling it "Your 5-step man-made system".

And "That came from Walter Scott and Alexander Campbell, not God."

I begged to differ.

#### Jesus Christ's teaching on the "5-steps"

This prompted me to look into what Jesus specifically said regarding the events to salvation. And curiously, not only did I find His thorough teaching on each 'event', but also how He put a "blessing and a curse" on each. He taught that a person's response to all of these 'steps' resulted in either salvation or damnation—no middle ground—the consequences of one's choices are serious.

#### **Jesus Christ on HEAR:**

"Therefore whosoever HEARETH these sayings of mine, and doeth them, I will liken him unto a wise man, which built his house upon a rock: And the rain descended, and the floods came, and the winds blew, and beat upon that house; and it fell not: for it was founded upon a rock.

# Sola Scriptura

### Was the practice of the early Church centuries before Calvin and Luther

Sola Scriptura (Lat., 'by scripture alone'). The belief that the truths of Christian faith and practice can and must be established from scripture alone, without additions from, e.g., tradition or development.

There is, brethren, one God, the knowledge of whom we gain <u>from the Holy Scriptures</u>, and <u>from no other source</u>. [Full quote: http://orthodox-apologetics.blogspot.com/2010/06/st-hippolytus-of-rome-sola-scriptura.html] ~ Hippolytus, A.D. 170 – 236

What more can I teach you, than what we read in the Apostle? For <u>holy Scripture setteth a</u> <u>rule to our teaching</u>, that we dare not be wise more than it behoveth to be wise.

Let nothing be innovated, says He, nothing maintained, except what has been handed down. Whence is that tradition? Whether does it descend from the <u>authority of the Lord and of the Gospel</u>, or does it come from <u>the commands and the epistles of the Apostles</u>? For that those things which are written must be done.

Let us not hear: This I say, this you say; but, thus says the Lord. Surely it is the books of the Lord on whose authority we both agree and we both believe. Someone may perhaps ask: Why do you want to remove those things from the midst? Because <u>I do not want the holy church proved by human documents but by divine oracles</u>.

Have thou ever in your mind this seal, which for the present has been lightly touched in my discourse, by way of summary, but shall be stated, should the Lord permit, to the best of my power with the proof from the Scriptures. For concerning the divine and holy mysteries of the Faith, not even a casual statement must be delivered without the Holy Scriptures; nor must we be drawn aside by mere plausibility and artifices of speech. Even to me, who tell you these things, give not absolute credence, unless thou receive the proof of the things which I announce from the Divine Scriptures. For this salvation which we believe depends not on ingenious reasoning, but on demonstration of the Holy Scriptures.
