That dollar bill and Dad's note to the management is more vivid in my memory than the boat ride itself. It would have been easy for anyone to "borrow" one of the unchained boats that There wasn't a soul around for miles. But for over thirty years I've been warmed from the inside out by the discovery that my father was indeed "one of the good guys" and by the lesson that honesty means being honest all the time, not just when someone else is watching.

Lord, help me to keep my conscience clear by doing the right thing, whether big or small, whether seen or unseen.


