
# L ghthouse of Iowa

Above all, I came to see the Bible as a whole, as the magnificent coherent unfolding of the Word of God. And along spiritual with these rewards, I enjoyed a sense of real accomplishment: I'd met the challenge, and the rewards outweighed all my expectations.


